## Cape wins multi-million pound BP North Sea contract extension

Hundreds of jobs could be secured after energy services firm Cape secured a two-year contract extension with oil major BP.

The deal, for work in the North Sea, is worth an estimated \$153million.

Cape will supply a range of services to six BP assets in the North Sea.

The contract win could secure up to 500 new jobs.

The company's chief executive Joe Oatley said: "We are delighted to be awarded this further contract by BP, which will allow us to continue to invest in our people through our apprentice, intern and graduate programmes.
